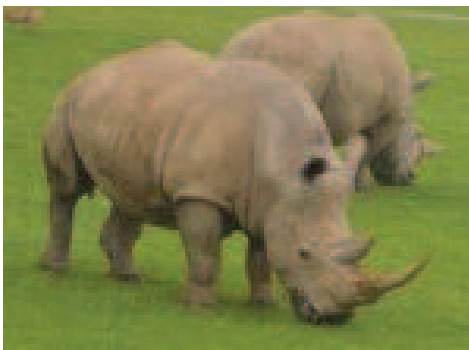

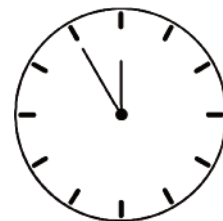
Change of contact details
