Some subject will be taught discretely depending on the focus of the chosen theme for the half term. These are indicated with a green border.

Mathematics and PE follow their own scheme of work throughout the year but have some links to the topics covered.

The Year 1 Mathematics topics for the Autumn Term are:

Number: place value	Number: addition and subtraction	Geometry: shape
<p>Counting to 120 forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1 of from any given number.</p> <p>Count in multiples of twos.</p> <p>Count, read and write numbers to 20 in numbers and words.</p> <p>Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line and use the language of equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most and least.</p> <p>Count in multiples of twos and fives.</p>	<p>Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20.</p> <p>Add and subtract one digit numbers to 20, including zero.</p> <p>Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.</p> <p>Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representation is a missing number problems such as $7 = ? - 9$.</p>	<p>Recognise and name of common 2D and 3D shapes including rectangles, squares, circles, triangles, cuboids, pyramids and spheres.</p> <p>Describe position, direction and movement including whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns.</p>

Pupils in Year 1 also have sessions during the week for phonics, guided reading and handwriting.

For Phonics we use the Sounds-Write programme and we start reading with the Dandelion phonic books.
