

Key stage 1 (KS1) Results

How well have our children achieved this year?

We will have our first KS1 results in 2018.

As parents you will know how your own children are progressing in school from their school reports. The schools end of year information is shared with Bedford Borough and information about outcomes for children in the Early Years (GLD), Year 1 (Phonics) and Year 2 and Year 6 are also shared with central government.

Pupil outcomes are shown in percentages and are compared with local and national figures.

This year at the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage 67.7% of our children achieved a GLD (Good Level of Development) in comparison with 66.7% in Bedford Borough¹ and 70.7% nationally.

At the end of Year 1 children complete a Phonic Screening Check. This year 70% of our pupils attained or exceeded the Phonics Screening threshold this is compared to 77.5% in Bedford Borough and 81.2% nationally.

Key Stage 2 (KS2) results

Assessing our pupils and tracking the progress that they are making is essential to teaching and learning. Assessment is a continuous process that takes place in school.

On entry to the school in the Early Years the children undertake a 'Baseline' assessment to identify their strengths and areas for development.

In Key Stage 1, children undertake the two statutory assessments. In Year 1 children take the Phonic Screening test at the end of the year. In Year 2 children take the Statutory Assessment Tasks (SAT's) during summer term.

In Key Stage 2, children in Year 3, 4 and 5 undertake non-statutory assessments. In Year 6 children undertake the end of key stage Statutory Assessment Tasks (SAT's). These results are reported individually to the parents/carers.

All children are monitored very carefully, if necessary intervention strategies are identified to help children who may have potential difficulties in some aspects of their learning. Where necessary the SENCO will undertake more detailed assessments.

This table shows the percentage of pupils at the end of Key Stage 2 achieving each level in 2017.
